- Paper Category: (e.g., Theology, NT, OT, Church History, Philosophy, Pastoral/Applied Theology, etc.)
- Proposed paper title
- 200–300 word abstract
- Willing to make live presentation if selected: YES // NO

Student Members of the Evangelical Theological Society who are part of the Southeast Region are also invited to submit a 200–300 word proposal to present a paper as part of the 2021 Southeast Regional Meeting of the Evangelical Theological Society. *The submission deadline for paper proposals will be Friday, January 22.* Proposals should be sent to: <u>ets@csuniv.edu</u> and should contain the following information:

- Presenter name, degree currently being pursued (e.g. PhD (ABD), PhD Student, ThM Student, MDiv Student)
- Institutional affiliation (school, church, or ministry name)
- Email address at which presenter wishes to receive Q&A
- Paper Category: (e.g., Theology, NT, OT, Church History, Philosophy, Pastoral/Applied Theology, etc.)
- Proposed paper title
- 200–300 word abstract
- Willing to make live presentation if selected: YES // NO

Members are encouraged to submit paper proposals on the conference theme: The Doctrine of God. However, submission on the conference theme is NOT required. Papers will be reviewed by the scholars on our program committee.

• All members whose papers are selected for presentation will be required to submit a 30minute video reading/explaining/summarizing their paper, *no later than noon, Friday, March 12* (a link for uploading videos will be provided though the email informing members that their paper has been accepted for the conference). Papers not submitted by this deadline will not be included in the conference.

- All student members in the Southeast region whose papers are selected for presentation:
 - Must submit their written paper via email (<u>ets@csuniv.edu</u>) *no later than noon, Friday, February 26.* These papers will be reviewed by the scholars on our program committee to be honored as the best student papers presented to the 2021 Southeast ETS meeting.
 - Must submit a 30-minute video reading/explaining/summarizing their paper, *no later than noon, Friday, March 12* (a link for uploading videos will be provided though the email informing members that their paper has been accepted for the conference). Papers not submitted by this deadline will not be included in the conference.
- Paper Presentations:
 - The program committee will invite the presenters of the 10 papers deemed "most promising" (as determined by the program committee) to present their papers to the conference via live Zoom Webinar. Priority will be given to proposed papers on the conference theme (Doctrine of God), These invitations will be extended on the basis of the paper proposals submitted, and will be issued by Friday, February 26.
 - The schedule for live presentations (five on Friday afternoon, March 19 and five on Saturday morning, March 20) will be posted on <u>www.churchandgospel.com</u> and at the Southeast Regional ETS page on the national ETS website on Friday, March 2.
 - Links to the Zoom Webinars will be made available to conference registrants at <u>www.churchandgospel.com</u> on Thursday, March 18. The URL for this page and a password to enable access to it will be distributed by email to everyone who registers for the conference prior to the end of the day on Thursday, March 18, or immediately upon registration thereafter.
 - Papers selected for live presentation will be recorded as the live presentations are made and will be made available on-demand at <u>www.churchandgospel.com</u> beginning Wednesday, March 24.
 - Live presentations should be no more than 30 minutes in length.
 - Live presentations will be followed by 10–15 minutes of live Q&A moderated by a session host. Conference attendees will be able to submit questions during the presentation via the Chat function in Zoom.
 - All pre-recorded conference paper videos will be made available for on-demand viewing by conference registrants at <u>www.churchandgospel.com</u> at the beginning of the conference on Friday, March 19.
 - The URL for this page and a password to enable access to it will be distributed by email to everyone who registers for the conference prior to the end of the day on Thursday, March 18, or immediately upon registration thereafter.

- This page will list papers by under two main categories ("Conference Theme" and "Other Topics") and by discipline-related sub-categories (e.g. Theology, New Testament, Church History, etc.).
- Finally, this password-protected page will make presenter names and email addresses available so that those who view the video presentations can submit questions to the presenters.
